Either born as a joke, abandoned from the wind-born Inanimae, or birthed from a Memeculture with too little attention span, the all-male Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man Kith has ran rampant across the American Youth's consciousness for longer than should be reasonably feasible. The creature which would eventually become known as Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing

Tube-Man was originally called the Tall Boy. Over the years however, the Kith has thriven exponentially in popularity, and since has gained such imaginative epithets as sky-dancer, airdancer, sky-tickler, or the slightly less florid Tube-Man. Yet in the psyches of the Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man's many fans, he has no other designation save Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man

Since its introduction in the early 90's the Kith has been met with varying degrees of esteem, both hated and cherished. In Fae Mien, the Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man looks much the same, though growing and lengthening in form and function. The flesh

and hair grow as bright and vibrantly colored as the clothing in which they so love, and the smiling eyes and flashing grins grow across their bright faces. There is also a distinct lack of chin.

Lifestyle: Their happy eyes and honest smiles allow the Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man Kith a modicum of success in most endeavors. They live lives in which they can be seen by the masses and thrive on the attention they get. Used Car-Salesmen, local Television personalities, small-town celebrities, as long as they can get a little lime-light, the Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-

Flailing Tube-Man are as right as rain.

Childing Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man garner many friends in their younger years due to their willingness to help their fellow youths and their sincere smiles. They will never say no to a challenge, and attack adversity with flailing pluck and wriggly determination.

Wilder Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man lose none of the enthusiasm that they had in their Childing years. They still adventure when needs deem must, and relish in the success of both themselves and their allies.

Grump Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man don't squirm with as much zest as they used do, and their flouncy floundering is decelerated with old-age. Despite this cessation of adroitness, they still enjoy their daring quests o 'fun and let nothing hinder them from engaging with their fans.

Revelry: Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man garner glamour by being seen and enjoyed. Not just by dancing in the spot-light but by engaging others to dance with them in said spot-light is the true means.

Unleashing: Cantrips cast by Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man are accompanied by splashes of color that wave and flicker and bounce across the scene in maddeningly dancing means. Those that aren't familiar over-much with the Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man's magics may grow disoriented at the jerky and flouncing color swathes that ricochet through the area.

Affinity: Actor

Birthrights:

Look at me!: Due to their colorful visages and twitchy movements, a Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man can spend one point of glamour and have everyone within sight turn their attentions toward him. There is no roll needed, and no bunk. All eves are instantly turned toward the Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man and his wacky hisucceed on a willpower roll difficulty of the Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man's Charisma + Performance rating or 8 (whichever is higher).

The Wriggles: The Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Mans have untold amounts of squirminess and this allows them for some truly stunning feats of suppleness. They gain a +3 to dexterity at Character Creation, even if above 5, gain the triple-jointed merit, and gain a +3 to all initiative rolls.

Frailties:

Can't Stop, Won't Stop, Don't Even Know how to Stop: While the wiggles and squiggling can prove of use much of the time, there are sometimes when it just grows tedious. Not that the Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man are aware of

it. They continue to move and shake what the Dreaming gave em' all day and all night. Even when asleep they tend to twitch and shimmy. Any rolls that involve stealth are instant fails.

In addition, they see nothing wrong with this. Let others worry about being stealthy, it is the job of the Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man to be noticed and loved. This results for some nerve- grating and strained interactions.

jinks. Anyone who wishes to not turn their attention must I'll stop: While it's great to party some-times, a non-stop dance-off can cause some turmoil among the Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man and his allies. When such altercations inevitably arise the Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man's allies, his dancing is sullen and sad, and he loses his Wriggles birthright, and is at a +1 difficulty to all rolls, as the wind is literally taken out of him. This lasts until those tired allies engage in another dance party with the Wacky Waving Inflatable Arm-Flailing Tube-Man, and convince him that bygones are bygones, and that they really want to have that dance-party, really!. (This may take a subterfuge + Charisma roll for unusually stuffy friends).
